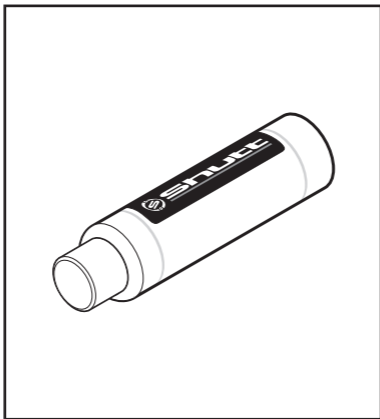

Instructions

Thanks for buying our product. Projected to join comfort and beauty, our products follow the most demanding patterns of quality.

Important recommendations:

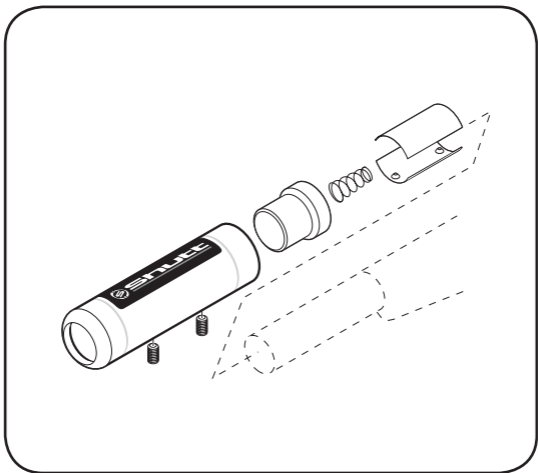
- 1) Before installation, read the instructions very carefully;
- 2) Use the adequate tools for installation of this emergency brake handle.

Content of this packing:

- 1) 1 (one) emergency brake handle;
- 2) 1 (one) lid for emergency brake handle;
- 3) 2 (two) little metal plates;
- 4) 2 (two) long screws and 2 (two) short screws;
- 5) 1 (one) coil;
- 6) 1 (one) allen screw driver.

Assembly project:

- 1) Loosen the screws using the allen screw driver;
- 2) Put the lid inside the emergency brake handle;
- 3) Put the coil (with the bigger diameter to inside);
- 4) Insert the little metal plates so that the screws stay in the direction of the holes in it;
- 5) Fit the set onto the axle;
- 6) If it presents looseness, use the non-perforated metal plate to adjust;
- 7) Tighten the screws using the allen screw driver.
